

Audio/Visual Tech Support

Only trained staff from Mount Hope are allowed to operate or adjust the sound equipment and be inside the sound booth. This includes soloists, musicians and videographers. The connection and operation of all outside equipment including microphones, instruments and video equipment into Mount Hope's Audio & Visual System must be overseen by a Mount Hope A/V Technical Staff.

Several services are available:

- Digital recording of a "traditional" wedding ceremony. This includes a wireless microphone pickup of the Groom and mic mixing of musicians if needed. You will receive one audio CD with jewel case.
Audio Tech \$25/ hour or \$50 (whichever is greater)
Additional audio CD's: \$15
- Audio Tech to playback pre-recorded audio CD tracks such as prelude, processional, special solo track, recessional and/or postlude music. If the wedding couple provides the CD mix, it must be in WAV or WMA format. No MP3 tracks accepted.
Audio Tech \$25/ hour or \$50 (whichever is greater)
- Audio Tech for live mixing of musicians without recording or playback. This requires rehearsal/ sound-check at least 1 hour before the wedding or else at the wedding rehearsal time.
Audio Tech \$25/ hour or \$50 (whichever is greater)
- Pre-recording live vocal or instrumental musicians or mixing a custom track from CD's for playback at the ceremony. CD's must be provided at least 2 weeks in advance.
Audio Tech \$25/ hour or \$50 (whichever is greater)
- Providing an audio feed for the videographer: \$20
